ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 20-02

11 **WHEREAS**, JCRLV 6 allows the Chief Judge to make “such orders as deemed
12 advisable” relating to local court rules and procedure; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the COVID-19 virus presents concerns regarding public health, and the
14 Court wishes to proactively intercede to help limit unnecessary in-person contact; therefore,

15 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the following temporary changes shall be
16 implemented immediately:
17

18 (1) Any person who is arrested on a Traffic¹ violation shall be administratively released
19 at the jail and ordered to appear in person at the Customer-Service Counter of the Traffic
20 Division no sooner than May 15, 2020;

21 (2) Any person who is arrested on a Community-Court bench warrant shall be released on
22 the person’s own recognizance and given a 2-week return date to appear at the
Community Impact Center at 3740 Royal Crest Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119; and


23 (3) Any out-of-custody person with an active bench warrant who appears at the
24 Customer-Service Counter of the Traffic Division shall have that person’s warrant
immediately recalled by the Court.

27 ¹ As used in this Administrative Order, a “Traffic” offense is an offense that has a demerit point value of four
28 (4) or less as determined by the Nevada Department of Motor Vehicles. Offenses with higher point values,
such as DUI, are not affected by this Administrative Order.
