Read Receipt Now Included on All Electronic Notices Sent to Bail Agents and Insurers, Effective April 1, 2018

During the 2017 Session of the Nevada Legislature, Assembly Bill 38 amended the Jaw relating to the electronic transmission of notices relating to bond forfeitures. The Jaw provides that "every bail agent and insurer authorized to write surety in this State and every subsidiary corporation of such an insurer shall maintain a means of receiving electronic transmissions and shall receive electronic transmissions made pursuant to NRS 178.502, 178.508 and 178.514."

On October 1, 2017, the Las Vegas Justice Court began sending notices electronically to all bail agents and insurers using the e-mail address on file with the Eighth Judicial District Court.

Assembly Bill 38 also requires that "[o]n and after April 1, 2018, a bail agent or insurer authorized to write surety in this State and every subsidiary corporation of such an insurer may receive a notice pursuant to NRS 178.502, 178.508 or 178.514 by mail only pursuant to a court order issued upon request by the bail agent or insurer for good cause shown."

- Note: It may be necessary to adjust your spam filters in order to ensure that e-mails from this address do not go into your junk-mail folder.

It will be necessary for the bail agent and insurer to verify that the e-mail was received. This is done by way of a two-step process:

- (1) Clicking on the provided link which will open a delivery receipt email to the Court.
- (2) Click "SEND."

If the Court's notice is not acknowledged as "received" within a 3-day time period, the Court will contact the bond company or insurer to verify that the Court's notice was received. If it was, the Court will request that an acknowledgement be e-mailed to the Court.
